

This year we have been faced with unprecedented challenges including how to safely offer flu vaccination to those who are eligible without increasing risks to patients and ourselves.

- We will be providing vaccination on a walk-through basis.
- You will be asked to book an appointment in one of our flu clinics. You will be asked about allergies at the time of booking. If this changes before your appointment, you need to notify us.
- You will need to wear a mask or face covering.
- You will be asked not to arrive early or late as there is no capacity for you to wait.
- You will not be able to use the toilet facilities.
- You will be asked to give your name to the staff at the desk.
- Please wear a vest or T-shirt underneath your coat so that you can immediately offer your **SHOULDER** for vaccination.
- We do not wish to touch you ourselves for infection prevention and control reasons.
- You will be directed to leave by a different exit so that you can avoid contact with patients who are still waiting.
- Please enter the building alone. If you need assistance to enter the building please let reception know when booking your appointment slot. If you have come with a friend /family member we will ask that they meet you at the exit and one of our members of staff will assist you through the clinic.
- Priority will be given to those at most risk and vulnerable. These patients will be invited first.
- **Future dates will be given when vaccines are available for those aged 50-64 with no other underlying health conditions. These vaccines are not expected until November/December 2020**
